

Applicants who do not hold a category D licence are eligible to join the Bus Eireann driver training programme. To progress to our driver training programme, candidates must have the following documents:

1. Valid *Irish* driving Category B or C (for a minimum of 2 years) with no endorsements.

2. Valid Category D licence Learner Permit

3. Valid CPC Business Case Study sheet

The flow chart below outlines the steps which applicants must complete prior to receiving a contract of offer to join the training programme.



Step 2: To obtain a Category D learner permit, candidates will firstly need to sit a theory test. For information on how to book Category D Driver theory test, click <u>https://theorytest.ie/book-your-theory-test/driver-theory-test-bus-or-truck/</u>
